The **30th edition of Manga Barcelona** will be a very special year for all manga and anime fans, as our MANGA BARCELONA celebrates 30 editions! In the planning of its activities we will enjoy great surprises and variety. Nevertheless, it will be an edition that will undoubtedly stand out for the visit of great mangakas. Among them is the author Naoki Urasawa, this year's guest of honor, who has also agreed to lend us his talent for the poster of the thirtieth edition.

Urasawa has become a legend since his debut in 1983. He has created unforgettable stories and extraordinary works that have been rewarded with an endless list of national and international awards. As a result, he was chosen as the poster artist for the 30th Manga Barcelona. As part of this reference event, the Tokyo-born Japanese author will set foot in the city of Barcelona for the first time.

The stars of this unique piece presented by the author of the poster will be the iconic characters that have accompanied the mangaka during his career. Characters that we can recognize from Urasawa's great works such as YAWARA!, Monster, Happy!, Billy Bat and 20th Century Boys. All of them, located in front of our Sagrada Familia, focus their gaze to frame this unique and unrepeatable encounter. A clear reference

to the arrival of Naoki Urasawa's entire universe in Barcelona. We are witnessing a personalized work dedicated to celebrating this thirtieth anniversary with the art of one of the most acclaimed genius in the world of manga.

In addition to the great mangakas already announced, such as Kamome Shirahama, Akasaka Aka or Yokoyari Mengo, **Takeshi Kawaguchi** and **Yuki Tabata** will join us as well. Takeshi Kawaguchi wrote the series Fate/Grand Order -turas realta-, the manga based on the videogame *Fate/Grand Order*. Yuki Tabata, the well-known author of the manga and anime **Black Clover**, will also visit the event. As for the music scene, we will welcome the group **Psychic Fever**, winner of the Next Generation Global Award in 2022. A boyband that will cause earthquakes to the rhythm of K-POP.

The most hardcore cosplay fans will be thrilled to hear that this year the show will feature the current winners of the World Cosplay Summit 2024. The Japanese team, a duo formed by **Mioshi** and **Mamemayo**, who won the highly relevant competition, have decided to pay us a visit with their talent this year. Another pair of cosplayers also joins this edition: **Fooly Cosplay**, consisting of Miquel Candela and Victor Fernandez from Barcelona.


The artistic father of our beloved **Onachan** will also be present at the 30th Manga Barcelona: **Carles Dal-**

-mau. The Catalan illustrator is known for his works Lucid Lucy and Calamari Kebab, and now as the creator of the mascot of Manga Barcelona.

30 years, 3 decades, Manga Barcelona started when our first big manga and anime fever was just beginning. It was a pioneering event and thirty years later it remains the benchmark. NAOKI URASAWA'S POSTER

It's probably a cliché, but such a special occasion deserves something special, and that's why we have the pleasure of having an exceptional poster for this 30th anniversary of Manga Barcelona. The author is none other than **Naoki Urasawa**, creator of very popular titles both in Japan and Spain, who is not only visiting us this year, but has been commissioned to illustrate the 30th anniversary edition.

Although this is the first time he has visited Barcelona (at least publicly), we have seen references to the city in his work for years. In his manga Yawara!, there is a judoka training for the 1992 Olympics, and some will remember an iconic manga panel of the protagonist smiling in front of Sagrada Familia. This manga was popular enough in Japan to have an anime and a live-action film with a part shot in Barcelona. In one of the posters of this movie, the protagonist couple appears in front of Sagrada Familia, in a similar manner to one of the protagonists of Pluto.

Coincidence or not, the new poster of Manga Barcelona has the emblematic building as one of the protagonists, and in the foreground appear some of the most famous characters created by Urasawa: Yawara and Jigoro Inokuma from *Yawara!*, Kenji from *20th Century Boys* with his guitar, Asa from *Asadora!*, Miyuki from *Happy!*, Dr. Tenma from *Monster*, and in the background, one of the biggest villains of manga: Amigo. Flying in the sky we can find *Billy Bat* from the manga of the same name, who, according to the author himself, was strategically placed to hide the scaffolding of the monument under construction. All these characters seem to have come to visit Barcelona, and we can't even imagine how many interesting stories could happen with all these characters together. Now the poster is all yours and you can let your imagination run wild!

POSTER AUTHOR & GUEST OF HONOR

Naoki Urasawa

Naoki Urasawa was born in Tokyo in 1960. Mangaka.

He made his debut in 1983 with the short story *Beta!* Since then, he has created relevant works such as **YAMARA!**, **MONSTER**, **Happy!** and **20th Century Boys**, among others.

In 2018, he exhibited the work *Mujirushi* in collaboration with the Louvre Museum in Paris, and is currently focusing on his latest work, the Asadora! series.


A three-time winner of the **Shōgakukan Manga Award**, Urasawa has also received many other national and international awards, including the Best Series Award at the Angoulême Festival in France, two Will Eisner Comic Industry Awards for the best American edition of foreign material - Asia, or the Lucca Comics and Games, in Italy.

His solo exhibition has reached national venues as well as the halls of four foreign countries, a clear indication of his international fame.






Takeshi Kawaguchi

Currently serializing 'Fate/Grand Order -turas realta-', the manga based on the game 'Fate/Grand Order', in Kodansha's 'Bessatsu Shonen Magazine'. For the game, he is in charge of character design of Chokaku.

The latest Japanese edition of 'Fate/Grand Order -turas realta-' is volume 18. The author's past titles include 'Jyoou heikano hokyusen'.

In Spain the manga is published by Ediciones Babylon.





Yûki Tabata

In 2001 he won the special jury prize at the 61st Tenkaichi Awards with the story *GRAVE KEEPER HAKAMORI* and three years later, in 2004, he received an honorable mention at the 67th Tezuka Awards with *XXX WITH NO NAME*. That allowed him to make his debut in 2005 in *AKAMARU JUMP* magazine with the work GARANCE.

In 2011 he won first prize in the Golden Future Cup with the work *HUNGRY JOKER*, which later became a regular series in WEEKLY SHÔNEN JUMP.

In 2015 he began publishing **BLACK CLOVER**, the series that has launched him to stardom, which already has 36 volumes published and more than 19 million copies in circulation Worldwide. It currently appears in the pages of Shueisha's JUMP GIGA magazine and has been adapted into an anime with more than 170 episodes produced so far.

In Spain the manga is published by NORMA Editorial.





PSYCHIC FEVER

PSYCHIC FEVER from EXILE TRIBE is a 7-member boy band formed in 2019 under LDH JAPAN. These top talents, honed at the LDH dance academy, debuted as PSYCHIC FEVER from EXILE TRIBE in July 2022.

PSYCHIC FEVER from EXILE TRIBE includes TSURUGI, RYOGA NAKANISHI, REN, JIMMY, KOKORO KOHATSU, RYUSHIN HANDA and WEESA.The group quickly gained recognition, performing alongside established LDH artists and winning awards like "Next Generation Global" at the 2022 GENIE MUSIC AWARDS. With their sights set on the global stage, they even spent 6 months in Thailand collaborating with local artists.

FOOLY COSPLAY

Fooly Cosplay is a cosplay duo from Barcelona, founded by **Miquel Candela** and **Víctor Fernández**. Although it was officially formed in 2014, its two members had already made their first steps in the world of cosplay since the beginning of Manga BCN.

Dragon Ball, Kinnikuman, Dr. Slump, Mazinger Z, Transformers or AKIRA are some of the anime on which they have based their creations, strongly influenced by the golden age of Japanese animation of the 80s and 90s. Over time, they have specialized in recreating large props that amaze everyone.

Winners of the Cosplay Contest of the last Cómic BCN in the category of the best armor or prop, they are constantly in search of ways to surprise and approach their projects in an innovative way, with humor and with the goal of doing something that has never been done before.

As a freelance illustrator, Shirahama has created numerous cover illustrations for DC Comics and Marvel Comics, including Star Wars: Doctor Aphra, Star Wars: The last Jedi, Batgirl and the Birds of Prey.







Yuka Fujikawa

Yuka Fujikawa is a Japanese manga artist.

In 2014, she began serializing the popular light novel "Mushoku Tensei" as a comic.

The comic version of "Mushoku Tensei" has been highly praised for its high quality and has become her masterpiece.



Juan Albarrán is a manga artist from Spain.

He started his career in 2013 as an inker, working for American publisher DC Comics on titles such as "Justice League", "Suicide Squad", etc. From 2020, he worked as a manga assistant in the Japanese manga industry, and is currently drawing his first serialization, **"Matagi Gunner"**, which started publication in 2022 on Kodansha's Morning magazine.









She won a special prize at the **Shueisha Shojo Manga Grand Prix** and made her debut in 2020 with the webtoon "Ice Wall."

She is currently serializing **"Opposites: You and Me,"** a story about a high school couple who just started dating, on Shueisha's manga magazine app "Shonen Jump+."






Hiroshi Nagahama

Hiroshi Nagahama (1970) is one of Japan's most prolific and multidisciplinary anime directors.

His work spans diverse productions such as the hilarious and disruptive **Detroit Metal City** (2009), the deeply original **The Flowers of Evil** (2013), which blended animation with rotoscoping, and **The Reflection** (2017), one of the last projects involving Stan Lee. Lee co-authored the anime with Nagahama, merging the worlds of anime and superheroes.

However, if one were to choose a single work to represent the Japanese director, that would be **Mushishi** (2005). In his early career as an animation director, notable works include **Revolutionary Girl Utena** (1997).





Sunghoo Park

Sunghoo Park, born in South Korean, has rightfully earned his place as one of the leading anime directors of the moment. After directing *Garo: Vanishing Line* and *The God of High School, Park* rose to fame thanks to his spectacular work on the first season of *Jujutsu Kaisen* for the studio MAPPA, which premiered at the end of 2020. A year later, he gained even more popularity with the series movie, *Jujutsu Kaisen 0*.

In his earlier years as an animator, he worked on numerous productions, including Yuri!!! on Ice, Zombie Land Saga, Tiger & Bunny, Wagnaria!!, Space Dandy, Macross Frontier, and Banana Fish.

In 2021, he founded his own anime studio, E&H production, from where he has already directed two productions: the new *Ninja Kamui* series for HBO Max and *Monsters: 103 Mercies Dragon Damnation*.

Yann Le Gall

Yann Le Gall, born in France, is one of the prominent European names who, for over a decade, has made a place for himself in the Japanese anime industry.

After years of working as an art and background designer on series like No Game No Life, Basquash!, AKB0048, FLCL Progressive, Cannon Busters, Fairy gone, and The Rising of The Shield Hero, Yann is now an art director at the studio E&H production, founded by Sung Hoo Park (Jujutsu Kaisen).

His most recent works as an art director, which he will discuss at MANGA Barcelona, include the new *Ninja Kamui* series for HBO Max, *Red Cat Ramen*, and the Crunchyroll original anime *Meiji Gekken* 1874.

Burnout Syndromes

Burnout Syndromes is a Japanese Rock Band from Osaka, formed in **2005**.

In 2010, they won the second Grand Prix at "Senkou Rionette", the band audition for teens held by TOKYO FM. In March 2016, they released **debut single** "FLY HIGH!!", and the title song "FLY HIGH!!" was used as the opening theme for the anime "Haikyu!! Second Season".

After the debut, their song "**Hikariare** (ヒカリアレ)" and "**PHOENIX**" was chosen as the opening theme for the anime "Haikyu!!" three times in a row for the first time.


In 1999, Maki Otsuki debuted with "**memories**", the first ED theme song for the TV anime ONE PIECE.

The second ending song "RUN! RUN! RUN!" followed and was also a smash hit.

In 2024, Maki Otsuki and Hiroshi Kitadani, the same duo who sang the first OP and ED songs for ONE PIECE came back with an opening and ending for the new anime season. **"Dear Sunrise"** is Maki Otsuki's newest song and the latest ending for the TV anime ONE PIECE.







Kazuso Oda (**Coda**) is a singer, lyricist, composer and a sound producer.

Debuted in January 2012 with "**BLOODY STREAM**", the opening theme for the second part of the TV anime "JOJO'S BIZARRE ADVENTURE". It has become a **hot topic**, reaching first place overall when distributed on the iTunes Store.

In 2019, released "**ebony & ivory**" a jazz arrangement cover album of JoJo's songs, with the Coda Piano Trio. He was the guitarist and vocalist for "No Regret Life" from 2001 to 2013 and also served as the singer for "Lost Words," the 9th ending theme of the TV anime "**Naruto**".






Carles Dalmau




Misty is a Catalan singer and songwriter. She has been involved in the world of music since she was a child, learning to play the guitar at the age of 13 when she even started composing her own songs.



They bring a lot of manga from Japan, the land of manga!






Japan Promotion supports the dissemination of the charm of Japanese culture, including art and crafts, as well as the overseas expansion of its practitioners.

That is why we continue to expand the space dedicated to children and their families, with activities throughout the four days and the exhibition on Japanese culture specially prepared for the youngest ones.







