A new event packed with guests and special, exclusive events.

December is here, and the air is filled with the scent of manga pages and your favorite ramen. The most eagerly awaited event of the year for lovers of Japanese culture is finally here! We are opening the doors of Fira Barcelona Gran Vía once again to offer four days full of premieres, special guests, and surprises. Following record-breaking editions, Manga Barcelona has become much more than an event; it has established itself as an unforgettable experience that connects art, culture, and the passion of its audience.

We are particularly enthusiastic about this year's celebration thanks to the generosity of Kamome Shirahama. The author of *Atelier of Witch Hat* has created a poster for Manga Barcelona, it is the second time in the event's history to have a poster illustrated by a mangaka. This milestone further reaffirms the union between Japanese mastery and Catalan essence.

The exceptional talent of this year's guests is unparalleled. In addition to the big names already announced, such as the incomparable Gou Tanabe, more renowned Japanese authors will be present, including Tsutomu Takahashi. He is a versatile and chameleonic artist known for pushing his characters and his readers to their limits. He is visiting us to present his latest titles: *Jumbo Max* and *Guitar Shop* Rosie. Akemi Takada, the great anime figure known for designing unforgettable characters such as *Lamu, Creamy Mami*, and *Madoka*, will also attend the event this year. Notable among the Japanese guests is Takashi Matsuyama, who will be present at 31 Manga Barcelona. His resourcefulness and creativity led him to become an assistant to the great Akira Toriyama throughout his professional career. He is largely responsible for the backgrounds that appear in the master's works and is a reference point for all those who started out in the art of manga with *Dragon Ball*.

This year, fans of the legendary series *Cowboy Bebop* will enjoy an unparalleled lineup of stars that has never been seen anywhere else. Shinichiro Watanabe, the director of *Cowboy Bebop, Samurai Champloo*, and *Lazarus*, will be there, along with Yoko Kanno, the SEATBELTS, and Mai Yamane. The latter are responsible for the soundtrack of this cult anime, and although more than 25 years have passed since its premiere, they have never performed outside of Japan. This special occasion will also include meetings with fans and joint interviews discussing the relationship between animation and music.

The Main Stage at Manga Barcelona will also feature rising star AiNA THE END, one of Japan's most prominent artists, known for performing the opening theme for the popular anime *Dandadan*. The iconic Kumamon, the mascot of Kumamoto Prefecture, will also be there. Kumamon is coming directly from Japan this year to participate in meet-and-greets and activities and to dance on stage with our beloved Onachan.

Once again, the Manga Auditorium will be filled with anime fans, who will be delighted by our program full of surprises and new offerings. One highlight is a tribute to Geki x Cine, a production company that brings spectacular Japanese plays to the big screen. This year, Geki x Cine will be joined by a small exhibition and its screenwriter, Kazuki Nakashima. Nakashima has worked not only in theater but also as the screenwriter of award-winning films at Manga Barcelona, such as Promare, as well as legendary Japanese series such as Kamen Rider. In collaboration with 3Cat, we will have three special screenings coinciding with three premieres on the TV channel. We will reveal the titles soon, but for now, we can announce that on Monday, December 8, at 1:30 p.m., there will be many Pikachus running around the Manga Auditorium. Oriol Estrada, the content advisor, comments: "We are thrilled that 3Cat has chosen Manga Barcelona to showcase some of its new series. We believe it's crucial for public television to support this type of content, and there's no better venue than the event to do so."

31 Manga Barcelona will fill the most iconic venues this year. Nihon Ryori will make your mouth water with its new program. Manga Kids will allow children to enjoy their otaku passion in a specialized space. Nihongo Experience will allow you to deepen and expand your knowledge of Japanese culture. Renowned companies will participate in the form of stands, further reinforcing the fair's international dimension. You can find everything from artisanal Japanese jewelry to the latest figures of your favorite characters.

All the elements that comprise the Manga Barcelona experience have contributed to its consolidation as an unquestionable reference point in the dissemination of Japanese culture. Meritxell Puig, the director of Manga Barcelona, points out that "with each passing edition, this gathering of manga and anime enthusiasts writes a new chapter in history, becoming a unique and irreplaceable experience that the public does not want to miss."

The soundtrack of Manga Barcelona will be louder than ever from December 5 to 8, 2025, at Fira de Barcelona Gran Vía.





TSUTOMU TAKAHASHI

Born in Tokyo in 1965, **Tsutomu Takahashi** is one of today's most renowned manga artists.

He debuted in 1989 with Jiraishin, and has since captivated readers worldwide with his ability to create intense stories narrated with realistic and expressive strokes.

His bibliography includes titles such as Detonation Island, Black-Box, Reverberation, and NeuN. These works traverse different universes, including street gangs, boxing, the mafia, and World War II.

Takahashi confronts his characters with extreme situations in dark atmospheres. In collaboration with Shogakukan, VIZ Media, and Norma Editorial, Takahashi is coming to Manga Barcelona to present his most recent works: the fast-paced thriller Jumbo Max and the drama Guitar Shop Rosie. These works reflect the breadth and versatility of Takahashi's career.

GOU TANABE

Born in 1975. He made his debut in 2001 with *Sunakichi*, which won the Special Jury Prize at the *Afternoon* Magazine Shiki Awards (jury: Kaiji Kawaguchi). In 2002, his adaptation of *Twenty-six Men and a Girl*, originally by Maksim Gorky, received an honorable mention at the fourth edition of Enterbrain's Entame Awards.

His most notable works include *Saudade* (script by Carib Song) and *Kasane* (based on the novel *Shinkei Kasane-ga-fuchi* by Enchō San'yūtei and with a script by Hiroaki Takeda). Since adapting *The Outsider* by H. P. Lovecraft in 2004, he has continued to tirelessly and ambitiously adapt the author's works. The artistic quality of his work has earned him widespread recognition around the world.



SHINICHIRO WATANABE

Shinichiro Watanabe is one of the most influential figures in global anime—and for good reason. He's the original creator and director of iconic titles like *Cowboy Bebop* (1998), the space western that became a cult classic and was adapted into a live-action series by Netflix in 2021.

The adventures of Spike and his crew marked the beginning of Watanabe's remarkable career, which would later bring us Samurai Champloo (2004), Kids on the Slope (2012), Terror in Resonance (2014), Space Dandy (2014), and Carole & Tuesday (2019)—series in which the Japanese director blends drama, science fiction, and comedy, always with music at the heart of the story. His collaborations with artists like Yoko Kanno and the late Nujabes are central to his unique audiovisual storytelling.

In 2025, Watanabe returns with **Lazarus**, a sci-fi series set in the year 2052, produced by MAPPA for Adult Swim and streaming on HBO Max.

YOKO KANNO

Yoko Kanno is not just a composer—she's a sonic storyteller, a genre-bending magician, and one of the most influential figures in anime music history. Best known as the mind behind the iconic sounds of Cowboy Bebop and Ghost in the Shell, she's spent decades creating unforgettable scores that range from jazz and classical to electronica, blues, ambient, and experimental rock. You never know where a Yoko Kanno soundtrack will take you—but it's always somewhere extraordinary. And of course, she leads the enigmatic band SEATBELTS, responsible for bringing Cowboy Bebop's unforgettable soundtrack to life.

Her anime legacy is legendary. She first caught attention with the lush, cinematic score of **Macross Plus**, followed by the dreamy, emotional soundscape of **The Vision of Escaflowne**. Then came **Cowboy Bebop**—a genredefying explosion of jazz, funk, and cool that forever changed how music was used in anime. That was just the beginning.

SEATBELTS is a band of technical masters led by legendary composer **Yoko Kanno**, also known as Captain Duckling. They occasionally descend to Earth—and luckily, they're coming to Europe this December for the first time ever for a show at **MANGA BARCELONA**.

Known for their wild mix of jazz, blues, funk, and experimental sounds, SEATBELTS are the creators of the unforgettable soundtrack to *Cowboy Bebop*, one of the most influential anime series of all time. From the explosive opening theme *Tank!*, to the soulful ending *The Real Folk Blues*, the emotional *Space Lion*, and the energetic *Rush*, SEATBELTS helped define the show's unique identity—and left a mark on anime music history.

MAIYAMANE

Mai Yamane is a renowned Japanese singer and lyricist. She began her musical career in 1979 after winning the Yamaha Music Foundation's Cocky Pop. In 1980, Yamane released her first album, Tasogare (tare tare tare), which became a defining work in the city pop genre. Her husky, soulful voice and sophisticated arrangements resonated with the urban Japanese youth of the 1980s.

In the 1990s, Yamane transitioned into anime music, collaborating with composer **Yoko Kanno**. Her most prominent work includes contributions to the acclaimed anime series **Cowboy Bebop**, where her vocals featured in tracks such as **The Real Folk Blues**, **Blue**, **Don't Bother None** or **Gotta Knock a Little Harder**.

Beyond Cowboy Bebop, Yamane's anime contributions include songs for Macross Plus (After, in the Dark), The Vision of Escaflowne (If You) and Darker than Black, among others.

AINA THE END

With a voice like no other, **AiNA THE END** has become one of Japan's most exciting artists—and if you need proof, just listen to *On The Way*, the opening theme for Season 2 of **DAN DA DAN**. Since the end of **BiSH**, the legendary idol group she was part of from 2015 to 2023, her solo career has taken off, especially in the anime world. Her songs have featured in major hits like *Gundam: The Witch from Mercury* (*Red:birthmark*), **The Apothecary Diaries** (*The Spell*), and **Mononoke: Phantom in the Rain** (*Love Sick*), whose music video won big at the MTV Video Music Awards Japan.

But AiNA THE END isn't just a voice. She writes her own music, takes bold creative risks, and acts too—she starred in *Kyrie* (2023), a film by acclaimed director Shunji Iwai, and has collaborated with artists like Kenshi Yonezu or Mondo Grosso. With three solo albums since her 2021 debut and a string of sold-out shows—including a headline performance at the Budokan, now streaming on Prime Video—AiNA's only getting started. Her next stop? **MANGA BARCELONA**, marking her first-ever show outside Asia. Don't miss the chance to see Japan's next big star live on stage.



KAZUKI NAKASHIMA

He was born on August 19, 1959, in Fukuoka Prefecture. He joined the Gekidan ☆ Shinkansen company as a resident playwright in 1985 with The Flame's Hyperstep. His scripts, including The Seven of the Skull Castle, Ashura-yo no Hitomi: BLOOD GETS IN YOUR EYES, and Goemon Rock, are often based on history and myth. They emphasize story construction and intricate plots based on small clues. Combined with energetic direction, these works have become emblematic of the company.

He has had a long and interesting career in anime. He wrote the screenplay for Promare (2019) and created and wrote the script of Kill la Kill (2013). He also wrote the series Nodame Cantabile: Finale (2010), Gurren Lagann (2007), Crayon Shin-chan: Intense Battle! Robo Dad Strikes Back (2014), and Batman Ninja.



Mao Momiji is a Japanese foodie artist. In his appetizing illustrations, special attention is put on light and colours. He graduated from the Oil Painting Department of Musashino Art University. In Spring of 2019, he started to upload a new illustration every day to his Instagram account, which now has more than 190 000 followers.

In Autumn of 2020, he held his first solo exhibition, 365 delicious days, to huge acclaim in Tokyo. He has held exhibitions in other Japanese cities, as well as in Taiwan, New York and Los Angeles. His dream is to exhibit his works in all five continents, and to taste (and draw) all the delicacies that exist in this world. Mao Momiji is the official food designer of the anime Delicious in Dungeon (2024). In Japan, the publisher Parco Shuppan released two of his artbooks. In Spain, Ediciones Tomodomo published his first book **Platos** con **¡PINTAZA!**




ANDREA DALIA AYENN W.




JOAQUÍN ÁNGEL PONCE VIVES

H. P. Lovecraft is widely regarded as one of the founding fathers of modern horror. His monsters and his vision of human insignificance in the face of infinity have inspired generations of writers and artists. Gou Tanabe embraces this legacy, translating it into the language of manga with extraordinary visual power.

This exhibition shows how drawing can give shape to what Lovecraft created with words. Through the sections Cthulhu and Other Monsters, Ruins of Other Worlds, Landscapes of Desolation and Terror, Transmutation, and Descent into Madness, we will explore Tanabe's interpretation of the Lovecraftian cosmos.

SANT JORDI. FROM AUCA TO ÔTSU-E

This unique exhibition is the result of a collaboration between Escola Joso in Barcelona and Seian University of Art and Design in Japan. This experience has been an opportunity for students from two very different cultures to work on an artistic tradition that is distinct yet, at its core, very similar.

A professor from each institution taught a class to the students of the other school, each explaining a historical precedent of comics: the auca, a traditional Catalan form that uses illustrations to narrate stories in sequence, and the Ôtsu-e, a popular Japanese style of images and texts that reflect everyday life and traditional legends.

- The MANGA STREAM is the space open to the public that will host interviews and activities that will be broadcasted live during the four days.




