A MAGICAL, GAUDINIAN POSTER FOR AN EDITION FULL OF SURPRISES

The 31st edition of Manga Barcelona once again connects Catalonia and Japan through art, music, and a magical, modernist-inspired poster by Kamome Shirahama.

After the celebration of its 30th anniversary, Manga Barcelona continues to look to the future with enthusiasm, drawing on the strength that has made it a benchmark event for the last three decades. This new edition features exceptional guests, exclusive proposals, and a spectacular poster.

Kamome Shirahama, author of *Atelier of Witch Hat*, was one of last year's special guests. She was enchanted by Manga Barcelona, which is why she wanted to design the poster for this 31st edition. The poster features Coco, the protagonist of her famous manga, accompanied by someone very special: the Manga Barcelona mascot, Onachan! And, as one would expect, Shirahama was inspired by modernist art and Gaudí to create this beautiful poster. Meritxell Puig, the director of Manga Barcelona, said, "We are honored to have an artist of such authenticity and artistic sensitivity illustrate this year's edition. It's a magical poster that once again brings together Catalan culture and Barcelona with manga and Japan."

We are still working on this year's guest list, but we can already announce some of the authors and artists who will be visiting us this edition. The first confirmed guest is the exceptional Gou Tanabe, who is best known for his manga adaptations of the works of American writer H.P. Lovecraft. We will also be joined by Satoru Nii, an author famous for the manga series *Wind Breaker*. For fans of illustrated gastronomy, Mao Momiji will be joining us. He is an artistic genius who can bring the most exquisite dishes to life through his hyper realistic illustrations.

As for anime and music guests, we have a very special combination this year. First, Shinichiro Watanabe will visit us. He is the director and creator of one of the most acclaimed anime series of the last 25 years: *Cowboy Bebop*. Watanabe has also directed gems such as *Samurai Champloo*, and he recently released *Lazarus*, one of the most notable series in recent years.

Cowboy Bebop is also known for having one of the most celebrated opening songs and soundtracks in anime history. Yoko Kanno and the Seatbelts composed the music. Oriol Estrada, content advisor for Manga Barcelona, announced that: "For the first time outside of Japan, the singer and the group will come together to offer a memorable concert, turning Manga Barcelona into the setting for a very special event!" The concert will take place on Friday, December 5, 2025. The band will perform their anthems during the 31st edition of Manga Barcelona in an exclusive concert. To add to the celebration for Cowboy Bebop fans, Yoko Kanno and Shinichiro Watanabe will discuss together their collaboration on the legendary soundtrack.

With each edition, the Manga Barcelona auditorium has solidified its reputation as a destination for fans of Japanese animation, consistently drawing larger audiences. For now, we can announce three screenings for this edition. First is one that has become a tradition: the screening of *Detective Conan*, dubbed in Catalan, on Monday afternoon. This year, we will screen *Detective Conan*: *One-Eyed Flashback*. Next, we have two birthday celebrations. To celebrate Studio Ghibli's 40th anniversary, we will show *Whisper of the Heart* on Sunday. This lesser-known film could be described as a cult classic. Finally, on Saturday, we will celebrate the 30th anniversary of *Memories*, the work of manga and anime genius Katsuhiro Otomo.

Our beloved mascot will be the star of this edition again, this time with a new exhibition: Onachan's Room. This space will allow us to explore their personal space and learn about their passion for otaku culture. Other returning spaces at Manga Barcelona include Takeshita Barcelona St., which will transport you to the iconic Harajuku street, and the Nagomi Area, which will offer the best handmade and original Japanese products.

As a new feature this year, we are introducing additional ticket options. Visitors can purchase an Onachan Fast Pass, which offers preferential access via an exclusive queue, allowing them to move more quickly during the event. Because Manga Barcelona values families and recognizes the generational shift, the Family Pack now includes a children's ticket. This reduced-price ticket aims to make it easier for children to join us and experience these special days.

As the date of the event that fans of Japanese culture look forward to with great anticipation approaches, the time left is dwindling. However, many surprises are still to be revealed. As usual, you will need to keep an eye on social media and upcoming announcements, so you don't miss any details about this edition.

Ticket sales will begin at the end of July. We look forward to seeing you from December 5 to 8, 2025, at Fira de Barcelona Gran Via.

GOU TANABE

Born in 1975. He made his debut in 2001 with *Sunakichi*, which won the Special Jury Prize at the *Afternoon* Magazine Shiki Awards (jury: Kaiji Kawaguchi). In 2002, his adaptation of *Twenty-six Men and a Girl*, originally by Maksim Gorky, received an honorable mention at the fourth edition of Enterbrain's Entame Awards.

His most notable works include *Saudade* (script by Carib Song) and *Kasane* (based on the novel *Shinkei Kasane-ga-fuchi* by Enchō San'yūtei and with a script by Hiroaki Takeda). Since adapting *The Outsider* by H. P. Lovecraft in 2004, he has continued to tirelessly and ambitiously adapt the author's works. The artistic quality of his work has earned him widespread recognition around the world.







SATORU NII

In 2016, made manga debut with "Girls Mixed in the Boys' Badminton Club Secret Badminton Club" (Manga Box). Currently, "WIND BREAKER" is serialized in Magazine Pocket. The tankobon has been published up to volume 22, and the total circulation has surpassed 8 million copies.

This work has gained attention not only for its TV anime adaptation but also for stage and game adaptations, and a movie adaptation has also been decided.








YOKO KANNO

Yoko Kanno is not just a composer—she's a sonic storyteller, a genrebending magician, and one of the most influential figures in anime music history. Best known as the mind behind the iconic sounds of Cowboy Bebop and Ghost in the Shell, she's spent decades creating unforgettable scores that range from jazz and classical to electronica, blues, ambient, and experimental rock. You never know where a Yoko Kanno soundtrack will take you—but it's always somewhere extraordinary. And of course, she leads the enigmatic band SEATBELTS, responsible for bringing Cowboy Bebop's unforgettable soundtrack to life.

Her anime legacy is legendary. She first caught attention with the lush, cinematic score of **Macross Plus**, followed by the dreamy, emotional soundscape of **The Vision of Escaflowne**. Then came **Cowboy Bebop**—a genre-defying explosion of jazz, funk, and cool that forever changed how music was used in anime. That was just the beginning.







SEATBELTS

SEATBELTS is a band of technical masters led by legendary composer **Yoko Kanno**, also known as Captain Duckling. They occasionally descend to Earth—and luckily, they're coming to Europe this December for the first time ever for a show at **MANGA BARCELONA**.

Known for their wild mix of jazz, blues, funk, and experimental sounds, SEATBELTS are the creators of the unforgettable soundtrack to *Cowboy Bebop*, one of the most influential anime series of all time. From the explosive opening theme *Tank!*, to the soulful ending *The Real Folk Blues*, the emotional *Space Lion*, and the energetic *Rush*, SEATBELTS helped define the show's unique identity—and left a mark on anime music history.







MAI YAMANE

Mai Yamane is a renowned Japanese singer and lyricist. She began her musical career in 1979 after winning the Yamaha Music Foundation's Cocky Pop. In 1980, Yamane released her first album, **Tasogare** (たそがれ), which became a defining work in the city pop genre. Her husky, soulful voice and sophisticated arrangements resonated with the urban Japanese youth of the 1980s.

In the 1990s, Yamane transitioned into anime music, collaborating with composer **Yoko Kanno**. Her most prominent work includes contributions to the acclaimed anime series **Cowboy Bebop**, where her vocals featured in tracks such as **The Real Folk Blues**, **Blue**, **Don't Bother None** or **Gotta Knock a Little Harder**.

Beyond Cowboy Bebop, Yamane's anime contributions include songs for Macross Plus (*After, in the Dark*), **The Vision of Escaflowne** (*If You*) and **Darker than Black**, among others.







SHINICHIRO WATANABE

Shinichiro Watanabe is one of the most influential figures in global anime—and for good reason. He's the original creator and director of iconic titles like **Cowboy Bebop** (1998), the space western that became a cult classic and was adapted into a live-action series by Netflix in 2021.

The adventures of Spike and his crew marked the beginning of Watanabe's remarkable career, which would later bring us **Samurai Champloo** (2004), **Kids on the Slope** (2012), **Terror in Resonance** (2014), **Space Dandy** (2014), and **Carole & Tuesday** (2019)—series in which the Japanese director blends drama, science fiction, and comedy, always with music at the heart of the story. His collaborations with artists like **Yoko Kanno** and the late **Nujabes** are central to his unique audiovisual storytelling.

In 2025, Watanabe returns with **Lazarus**, a sci-fi series set in the year 2052, produced by MAPPA for Adult Swim and streaming on HBO Max.








AINA THE END

With a voice like no other, **AiNA THE END** has become one of Japan's most exciting artists—and if you need proof, just listen to *On The Way*, the opening theme for Season 2 of **DAN DA DAN**. Since the end of **BiSH**, the legendary idol group she was part of from 2015 to 2023, her solo career has taken off, especially in the anime world. Her songs have featured in major hits like *Gundam: The Witch from Mercury* (*Red:birthmark*), *The Apothecary Diaries* (*The Spell*), and *Mononoke: Phantom in the Rain* (*Love Sick*), whose music video won big at the MTV Video Music Awards Japan.

But AiNA THE END isn't just a voice. She writes her own music, takes bold creative risks, and acts too—she starred in *Kyrie* (2023), a film by acclaimed director Shunji Iwai, and has collaborated with artists like Kenshi Yonezu or Mondo Grosso. With three solo albums since her 2021 debut and a string of sold-out shows—including a headline performance at the Budokan, now streaming on Prime Video—AiNA's only getting started. Her next stop?

MANGA BARCELONA, marking her first-ever show outside Asia. Don't miss the chance to see Japan's next big star live on stage.








MAO MOMIJI

Mao Momiji is a Japanese foodie artist. In his appetizing illustrations, special attention is put on light and colours. He graduated from the Oil Painting Department of Musashino Art University. In Spring of 2019, he started to upload a new illustration every day to his Instagram account, which now has more than 190 000 followers.

In Autumn of 2020, he held his first solo exhibition, 365 delicious days, to huge acclaim in Tokyo. He has held exhibitions in other Japanese cities, as well as in Taiwan, New York and Los Angeles. His dream is to exhibit his works in all five continents, and to taste (and draw) all the delicacies that exist in this world. Mao Momiji is the official food designer of the anime Delicious in Dungeon (2024). In Japan, the publisher Parco Shuppan released two of his artbooks. In Spain, Ediciones Tomodomo published his first book **Platos con ;PINTAZA!**








TURN OFF YOUR CELL PHONES, THIS IS A MOVIE THEATER!




